  - A. God is Glorious.
  - B. God is Incorruptible (Psalm 90:2).
  - C. Mankind Robs God of Both.
- II. Mankind Substitutes God's Glory with Man-made Religion Romans 1:23b.
  - A. Mankind Makes Humans into gods (Exodus 20:4, 5).
  - B. Mankind makes animals into gods (Exodus 32:8; Isaiah 44:9-20).
  - C. This Fallen, Rationalized Religious Substitution is seen in:
    - 1. Anthropology.
    - 2. Psychology.
