Romans 1:24 - Wrath Revealed (Part 1) - God Abandons Mankind to Impurity.

- Theme: God justly abandons mankind to impurity because of man's rejection of God (Psalm 81:11, 12; Hosea 4:17).
- I. God Want Us to Notice Who Abandons Mankind Romans 1:24a.
 - A. Released without a Cushion.
 - B. Downhill without a Brake (Jonah 1:3, 5; 2:5; Revelation 22:1).
- II. God Wants Us to Notice to What Mankind is AbandonedRomans 1:24b.
 - A. The Expression of this Abandonment is Man's Heart's Lusts Ro 1:24b (Matthew 15:19, 20; Jeremiah 17:9).
 - B. The Essence of this Abandonment is Impurity (mostly morally, sexually) Ro 1:24c (2 Corinthians 12:21; Galatians 5:19-23; Ephesians 5:3; 1 Thessalonians 4:1-7).
 - C. The Extent of this Abandonment is Dishonored Bodies Ro 1:24d (Ecclesiastes 9:3; 1 Corinthians 6:13).
